


Intro to policy and advocacy – what do we do?


- Raise profile of REScoops to decision makers and stakeholders

The Winter Package: what is it?




- Main vehicle for implementing the EU's commitments under the Paris Climate Change Agreement, and for transforming its economy
- 3 Main Goals:
 - 1) Putting energy efficiency first
 - 2) Achieving global leadership in renewable energy
 - 3) A fair deal for consumers





The Winter Package: what is it?





Opportunities to fight for

- Acknowledgment / definitions of community energy / prosumers in EU legislation
- Rights to participate in renewables production and other activities across energy system
- Bike lane for participation in support schemes
- Right to access markets, and receive equal / proportionate treatment
- Supportive national legal frameworks for REScoops



State of play:

Where we are now:

- European Parliament proposing legislative amendments
- Member States forming views on the proposals, starting to debate own amendments

What we are doing:

- Submitting text/legislative arrangements to MEPs and Member States
- Sharing and explaining our position
- Through Policy Working Group: Mobilising members to influence national governments
- Working through Community Energy Coalition to build support
